If you park without displaying your valid Handicap Parking disability certificate or plate in a marked Handicap space, you could be fined up to \$200 for parking in or obstructing an access aisle. So, to be clear, if you have a valid Handicap Parking plate or placard, you have access to the marked Handicap Parking spaces within the show if one is available.

Council approves new downtown parking ordinance

The City Council approved an ordinance change. The new ordinance gives Council authority by resolution to restrict the parking of any motor vehicle, trailer, snowmobile, or bike of any kind in the Business District of the City.

The revised ordinance expands the definition of the Business District to include Charles St. from 8th Ave. E. (extending if from Charles and 7th Ave. E. The newly approved ordinance also adds the following restriction that from June 1 through October 1 that no vehicle shall park in any area of the Business District for more than two hours between the times of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Private Parking Lot Parking

For those that come early (some as early as noon) the spots you fill in front of the businesses interfere with the businesses that help pay for the show. The show is a great place to spend your evening, ignoring the rules and causing the sponsors to lose customers will jeopardize the funding of the show. If their parking is taken up by classic cars so their customers can't park, they will complain to the city. If the city gets complaints, they will cancel the permits and the show will be shut down! Help us continue to provide the show so we all have a place to come on Friday nights. For those that think we don't notice, having your wife bring the daily driver and then taking that spot when she leaves is not acceptable. Please take note, the parking lots at "The River of God Church" and "Franklyn Center" are both privately owned parking lots. They both went out and purchased new signage through the city that states "Private Lot No Car Show Parking until after 5:30 Violators Towed at Owners Expense". Unless you don't mind seeing your car loaded on a flatbed and hauled away, please heed this



warning. Bringing your newer than 1975 car earlier than 6:00 and then staying is just bad form and it makes a lot of people "upset" (to say the least). North St. Paul has a two-hour parking limit during non-show hours, so if you try these tactics, you are subject to a ticket. Remember, all the people in yellow shirts are volunteers – no one is getting paid. The History Cruze is a non-profit organization. The money we get from vendor fees and sponsorships helps fund the show (permit fees, insurance, porta-potties, etc.) and any funds left at the end of the year goes to local charity. Help us continue to provide one of the largest weekly free to participant and spectator shows around. Shows start at 6:00 pm and go to 10:00pm (subject to rainouts or if everyone leaves early because of darkness)


