

History Cruze in North St. Paul

The North St. Paul History Cruze is once again in full swing starting on the first Friday of June and runs for 16 weeks with the exception of one week. As always, we close the Friday of the MSRA Back to the '50's show at the Minnesota Fair Grounds. We normally close that week not due to lack of cars but lack of volunteer help. Many of our volunteers want to go to the MSRA show that weekend so we don't have enough volunteers to run the show safely.

For those that come early (some as early as noon) the spots you fill in front of the businesses interfere with the businesses that help pay for the show. The show is a great place to spend your evening, ignoring the rules and causing the sponsors to lose customers will jeopardize the funding of the show. If their parking is taken up by classic cars so their customers can't park, they will complain to the city. If the city gets complaints, they will cancel the permits and the show will be shut down! Help us continue to provide the show so we all have a place to come on Friday nights. For those that think we don't notice, having your wife bring the daily driver and then taking that spot when she leaves is not acceptable. Please take note, the parking lots at "The River of God Church" and "Franklyn Center" are both privately owned parking lots. They both went out and purchased new signage through the city that states "Private Lot No Car Show Parking until after 5:30 Violators Towed at Owners Expense". Unless you don't mind seeing your car loaded on a flatbed and hauled away, please heed this warning.

Bringing your newer than 1975 car earlier than 6:00 and then staying is just bad form and it makes a lot of people "upset" (to say the least). North St. Paul has a two-hour parking limit during non-show hours, so if you try these tactics, you are subject to a ticket.

Remember, all the people in yellow shirts are volunteers – no one is getting paid. The History Cruze is a non-profit organization. The money we get from vendor fees and sponsorships helps fund the show (permit fees, insurance, porta-potties, etc.) and any funds left at the end of the year goes to local charity. Help us continue to provide one of the largest weekly free to participant and spectator shows around.

Shows start at 6:00 pm and go to 10:00pm (subject to rainouts or if everyone leaves early because of darkness)
